Recognized for their highly original and beautiful approach to free improvisation, performer/composers Tim Brady (electric guitar, electronics), Helmut Lipsky (violin) and Shawn Mativetsky (tabla, percussion) are well known artists to the Montreal public.

The trio specializes in totally free improvisation, but with such a finely tuned sense of listening and musicianship that everyone assumes the entire concert has been meticulously planned in advance. Classical Indian rhythms meet jazz/rock guitar meet a 21st century Stephane Grappelli: all music becomes one and many with **Of Sound, Mind and Body**.

He shares the prize with emerging composer **Gabriel Dharmoo**, who will also sit in with the band for one tune!
